- 1) Starter Question: What is your impression of the book of Job?
- 2) Read the text aloud and discuss together any significant observations or issues needing clarification.
- 3) What is your reaction to Job’s opening statement: “I loathe my life” (v. 1)?
- 4) If someone you loved said those words to you, how would you respond?
- 5) Job’s friends offer lots of platitudes. Why do we say such things, and how can they do more harm than good?
- 6) How is Job being honest with God about his anger or frustration with him in v. 3?
- 7) How is v. 12 revealing Job’s underlying belief in God’s goodness and grace?
- 8) The lament of Job 10 ends without any resolution or hope. What does that teach us?
- 9) How is Christianity and the church uniquely situated to deal with the pain and suffering in this world?
- 10) Since Christians are practitioners of lament (and share in one another’s burdens), in what way(s) are you hurting or suffering right now?

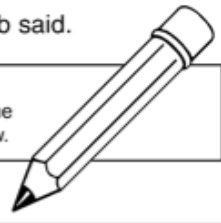
