- 3) What spiritual fruits do you see present in the church of Acts 2?
- 4) How is Acts 2:42-47 a “Great Commission” text?
- 5) In what ways does Christian community today look like the church of Acts 2?
- 6) In what ways does Christian community today fail to look like the church of Acts 2?
- 7) What is important about being together in Christ? How does being together help the disciple-making process?
- 8) How is being “together” in Christian community hard for our culture today?
- 9) In what ways does this text challenge you in your view of Christian community?
- 10) How can being “together” at Hope church better our disciple-making mission?
