1. Where do you see the practice of inflow pictured in Romans 15:13-14?
2. Who and what are the contributors to inflow listed in these verses?
3. Where do you see the practice of overflow described in Romans 15:13-14?
4. Who and what are the contributors to overflow listed in these verses?
5. The concept of inflow and overflow flows from the Greek word “Pleroo” and it’s various forms. “Pleroo” pictures a full-fullness rather than a partially or completely full cup that stops before it overflows. How are inflow and overflow “a both and” and not “an either or” in our disciple-making friendships?
6. List ways you see God inflowing into your life and the life of your closest friends?
7. List ways you see God overflowing from your life and into your life?
8. As you overflow who consistently benefits from the splash zone of overflow from your relationship with God and his family?
9. How do you see inflow & overflow in the following passages:
  - a. Romans 1:11-12
  - b. 1 Thessalonians 5:11
10. Where do you see inflow AND overflow in The Disciple-Maker’s Prayer?
