Introduction

In this passage, God teaches us that a goal of the disciple-making process is the growing of more laborers (disciple-makers).

The Text: Luke 10:1-12

- 1) Luke 10:1-2 "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to **send out laborers** into his harvest."
 - The prayer of a disciple-maker is for the Lord to provide more disciple-makers (laborers).
- 2) Luke 10:3-12
 - Disciple-making is a supernatural (God-directed) process.
 - Disciple-making is rooted in the teaching of the things of God.

Response: Disciple-making is multiplicative; whom does this include in your life?

• 2 Timothy 2:1-2: "You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus, and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also."

1)	Starter Question: Have ever been in a formal discipleship relationship? What was that like?
2)	Read Luke 10:1-12. What does Jesus ask of the 72 that were being sent out?
3)	What spiritual truths can we learn from Jesus sending out the 72?
4)	How does Jesus' prayer in Luke 10:2 challenge us as disciple-makers?
5)	Who can you be praying for in a disciple-making way?
6)	God supernaturally works in the process of disciple-making. Do you have any fears or worries when you think about making disciples?
7)	Who is someone in your life that you can help learn the Word of God?
8)	Where do you serve at Hope Church? What does it look like to multiply "laborers" in this ministry?
9)	Is anything preventing you from faithfully making disciples in your life?
10)What is one thing you are going to commit to this week concerning disciple-making? Pray for one another over these things.


Jesus Sends Out the 72

Circle the differences in the 2nd picture.








The 72 followers returned with joy. What did they and Jesus say?
