1. When you read John 20:21, how does it impact your thoughts about being sent?

2. John 1:14 tell us that Jesus came full of BOTH grace and truth. Do you tend to lean more towards grace, or towards truth? Can you share an interaction you have had that was impacted by this tendency?

3. Talk about someone in your life that you think has been an example of healthy balance between grace and truth. Explain how you have seen this in their lives?

4. In the exchange with the woman at the well in John 4, how do you see Jesus model a genuine relational approach as opposed to simply a preaching opportunity?

5. Can you talk about any relationships in your own life that you feel you should approach differently in light of the mutual and reciprocal interactions we have talked about through this series?

6. In John 4 we see that Jesus does not let cultural, religious, and moral differences hinder his relational grace filled approach of the woman. What steps could you take to remove these sorts of hindrances to your own relationships with unbelievers around you?

7. As we wrap up this series on relational disciple-making as a way of life, what has been the most challenging thing you have considered during this time?
