

Kingdom Come "The Lord's Prayer" Series Matthew 6:10a, p. 811 January 26, 2020 Pastor Casey Ehlers

## Introduction:

In Petition Two of the Lord's Prayer, Jesus teaches us to pray for the spread of God's lordship over His creation.

## The Text: Matthew 6:10a

1) Petition Two seeks for God's Fatherly reign to spread on Earth.

- 2) Petition Two directs our attention towards God's Kingdom.
  - a. The Parable of the Four Soils (Matthew 13:1-9): *The Kingdom is <u>HERE</u> and being accepted and rejected.*
  - b. The Parable of the Weeds (13:24-30): *The Kingdom is <u>PRESENT</u> and <u>WORKING</u> in our broken world.*
  - c. The Parable of the Mustard Seed (13:31-32): *The Kingdom starts <u>SMALL</u> but promises* <u>*GREAT GROWTH*</u>.
  - d. The Parable of the Leaven (13:33): *The Kingdom will one day <u>PREVAIL</u> over all worldly kingdoms and institutions*
  - e. The Parable of the Hidden Treasure (13:44): *The Kingdom is of great, sacrificial* <u>VALUE</u>.
- 3) The church is the "sign, instrument, and foretaste" of the Kingdom of God.
  - a. The church points people towards God's coming Kingdom. (SIGN)
  - b. The church loves neighbor through acts of kindness and justice. (INSTRUMENT)
  - c. The church loves one another and points to God's coming peace. (FORETASTE)

## **Response:**

Praying for God's Kingdom reign (Petition Two) calls us to trust in his **sovereignty** (control) and gives us a **hope-oriented posture** towards the world around us.

- 1. Starter Question: What is one change you would like to see happen in the world today? (example: a cure for cancer)
- 2. What are some of the main themes of Jesus' teaching? Would you consider the *Kingdom of God* one of them?
- 3. How does a biblical understanding of the word *kingdom* help explain the concept of the *Kingdom of God*? (hint: dynamic vs. static)
- 4. What does Jesus teach about the Kingdom of God through his parables in Matthew 13?
- 5. What have you learned about the *Kingdom of God* through his parables in Matthew 13?
- 6. How can Hope Church/your SG be a SIGN to the Kingdom of God?
- 7. How can Hope Church/your SG be an INSTRUMENT for the Kingdom of God?
- 8. How can Hope Church/your SG be a FORETASTE to the *Kingdom of God*?
- 9. What is one worry that you have in your life right now? How can this petition and God's fatherly reign minister to you through this trial/worry?
- 10. Do you have an optimistic or pessimistic attitude towards the world around you? How can this petition shape our view of the world as Christians?
