- (1) Gender is a gift from God distorted by sin, and redeemed by Jesus.
  - a. Creation: Genesis 1:26-28 (Gender is a good gift)
  - b. Fall: Genesis 11:1-9 (Gender is fallen [confused] and distorted by sin)
  - c. Redemption: Romans 6:3-11 (True identity is found in Christ and not gender)
  - d. Consummation: Revelation 21:1-4 (*The effects of sin on gender are no more!*)

  - i. "The experience of distress associated with the incongruence wherein one's psychological and emotional gender identity does not match one's biological sex." (Yarhouse)

  - a. God is sovereign and capable of saving whoever He pleases.

b. Jesus is faithful in ways Jonah couldn't be – who are we going to follow?
